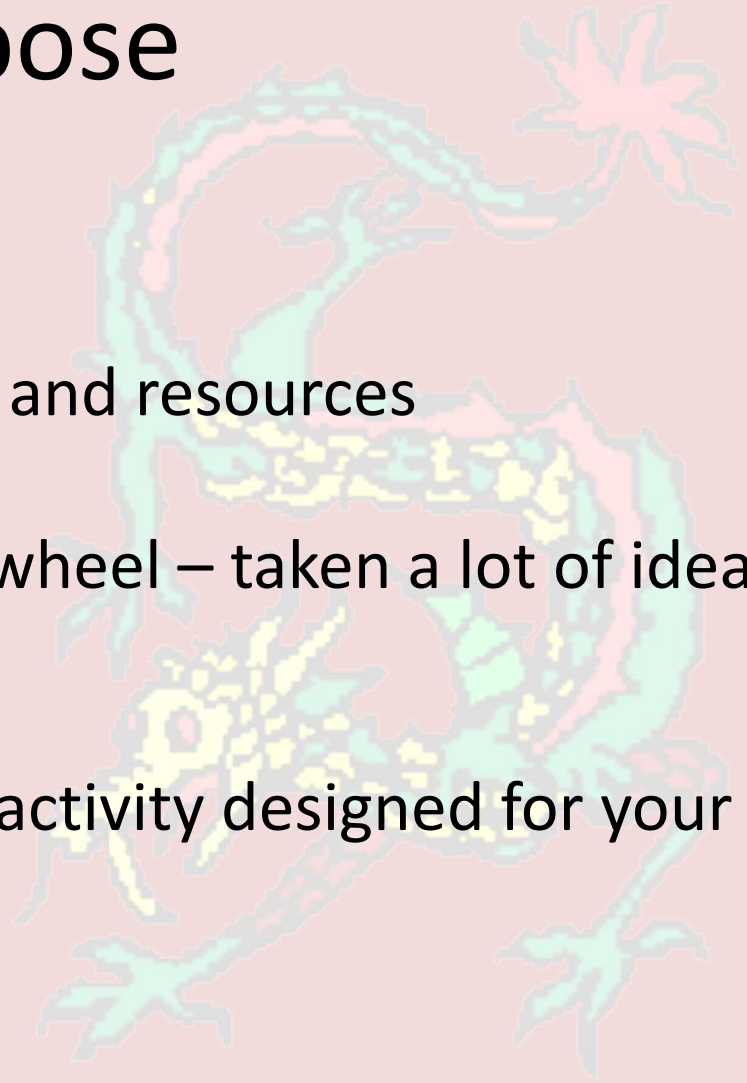

- Be inspired and resourced!



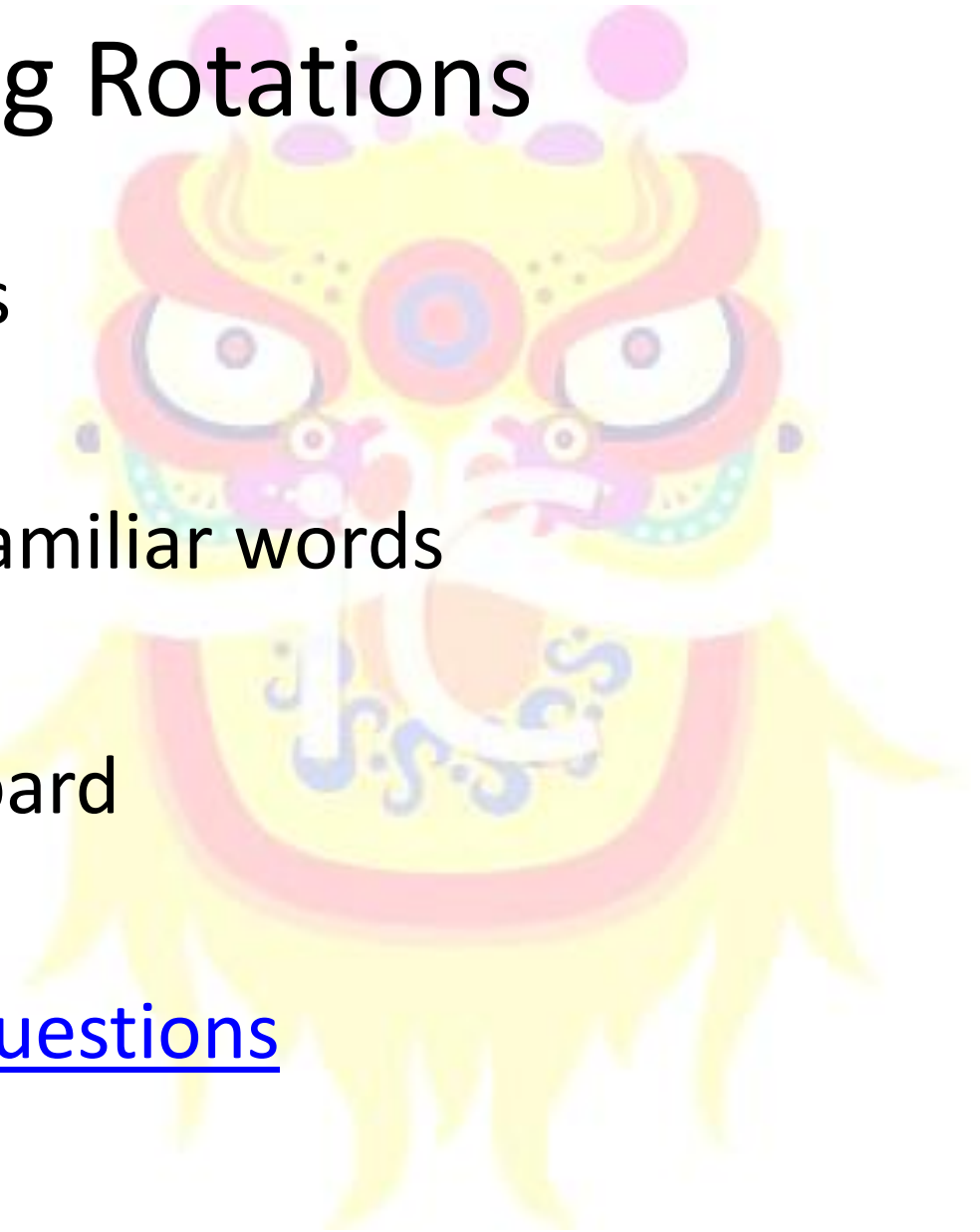
