The Confucius Institute at QUT (CIQ) annually recognises the excellence of teachers of Chinese in Queensland schools, through Teacher Awards in two categories. These awards are for 2014 registered full time school teachers of Chinese language teaching in Queensland only. The awards will be presented by the Director of the CIQ on Saturday, 1 November 2014, at an end of year celebration of the teaching of Chinese in Queensland schools. The event is also a networking and social opportunity for the teachers of Chinese, and supported by the Chinese Language Teachers' Association of Queensland(CLTAQ).¹

CATEGORY 1

The 2014 CIQ Excellence in Teaching Award

CIQ awards a teacher, for excellence in a school and its community for the teaching of Chinese language. The awardee will have made a *significant* contribution in developing Chinese teaching in their school. This may be shown in a number of ways. There will be one award for this category in 2014.

Currently registered teachers of Chinese will nominate a fellow teacher, in order for the nominee to be considered for this award. Nominees will have taught Chinese Language in 2014.

CATEGORY 2

The 2014 CIQ Excellence Award for Continuous Commitment to Professional Learning

CIQ awards teachers, for their continuous commitment to professional learning. Currently registered teachers of Chinese may make their own applications for this award. The continuous commitment to professional learning may be shown by a combination of: participation in specialised development programs for teachers of Chinese and/or programs for teacher development; and application of the professional learning in the school. This may include a range of professional areas related to the teaching of Chinese language. In this category for 2014, there will be the following awards of:

- 1. One prize "The 2014 CIQ Excellence Award for Continuous Commitment to Professional Learning"; and
- 2. Three prizes "The 2014 CIQ Merit Award for Continuous Commitment to Professional Learning".

Registered Queensland Teachers are eligible for nomination or application for these CIQ 2014 Teacher Awards. Nominations and Applications will be acknowledged via email.

The selections will be deemed final and appeals will not be considered.

The 2014 CIQ Excellence in Teaching Award

Nominations for this award are invited for teachers who are current full time teachers in Queensland schools in 2014. The award seeks to recognise the excellence in teaching Chinese language in schools.

This excellence may be shown through a combination of the following ways:

- 1. Initiatives to incorporate ideas about Chinese language and culture in other areas of the school curriculum;
- 2. Implementing strategies to involve school clusters and the school community to enhance student learning;
- 3. Establishing contemporary ways of learning in the teaching/learning process;
- 4. Use of ICT in teaching and learning approaches;
- 5. Introducing and managing various activities for teachers to share ideas for teaching and practice;
- 6. Initiatives to develop in regard to teaching skills and language competence;
- 7. Use of a variety of strategies to promote the language within the school community.

Process for Nomination

A registered teacher may nominate another teacher for this award. Please use the attached form.

In outlining the reasons for nomination, please refer to the above criteria.

2014 Award Prize

For 2014, the Award will be a voucher for educational resources to the value of *\$1000*. Alternatively, the awardee may be reimbursed up to *\$1000* for expenses to attend a related professional conference.

The 2014 Awardee will be announced on Saturday, 1 November 2014 at an end of year celebration, jointly hosted by CLTAQ and CIQ. Details of this event will be provided closer to the date.
