



2016 Teacher Awards

The Confucius Institute at QUT (CIQ) and the Chinese Language Teachers' Association of Queensland Inc (CLTAQ) annually recognise the excellence of teachers of Chinese in Queensland schools, through Teacher Awards. These awards are for 2016 registered full time school teachers of Chinese language, teaching in Queensland only.

The awards, from three categories, will be presented on Saturday, 19 November 2016, at an end of year celebration of Chinese teaching in Queensland schools held at the CIQ Offices at Kelvin Grove Campus of QUT. The event is also a networking and social opportunity for the teachers of Chinese. Award recipients must be present at the end of year celebration event to receive a prize.

The 2016 CIQ & CLTAQ Beginning Teachers Excellence in Chinese Teaching Award

CIQ and CLTAQ will award the 2016 Beginning Teachers Excellence in Teaching Award to teachers, who have made an *outstanding* contribution in Chinese teaching and learning in their schools as appropriate for a graduate to proficient educator. There will be two recipients of this award in 2016.

Nominations for this award are invited for teachers who are current full time teachers in Queensland schools in 2016 and have been teaching for between one and five years. Nominees will have taught Chinese in 2016.

The award seeks to recognise the outstanding beginning teachers of Chinese language. This may be shown through a combination of the following ways:

- 1. Taking initiatives to incorporate ideas about Chinese language and culture in other areas of the school curriculum;
- 2. Establishing contemporary ways of learning in the teaching/learning process;
- 3. Using ICT in teaching and learning approaches;
- 4. Introducing and managing various activities for teachers to share ideas for teaching and learning practice;
- 5. Taking initiatives to develop in regard to teaching skills and language competence;
- 6. Using a variety of strategies to promote the language within the school community.

A registered teacher will nominate another teacher for this award. Please use the attached form and submit an outline showing the evidence, referring to the above criteria. The outline should be no longer than two typed pages. In addition to these two pages, the nomination may contain materials such as testimonials from School Principals, parents, other teachers etc.

The 2016 CIQ & CLTAQ Excellence in Chinese Teaching Award

The awardee will have made a *significant* contribution in developing Chinese teaching and learning in their schools as appropriate for a highly accomplished and leading educator. There will be one award for this category in 2016.

Nominations for this award are invited for teachers who are current full time teachers in Queensland schools in 2016 and who have been teaching for more than five years. Nominees will have taught Chinese in 2016.

The award seeks to recognise the excellence of experienced teachers in teaching Chinese language in schools. This excellence may be shown through a combination of the following ways:

- 1. Taking initiatives to incorporate ideas about Chinese language and culture in other areas of the school curriculum;
- 2. Implementing strategies to involve school clusters and the school community to enhance student learning;
- 3. Establishing contemporary ways of learning in the teaching/learning process;
- 4. Using ICT in teaching and learning approaches;
- 5. Introducing and managing various activities for teachers to share ideas for teaching and practice;
- 6. Taking initiatives to develop in regard to teaching skills and language competence;
- 7. Using a variety of strategies to promote the language within the school community;
- 8. Helping/mentoring others.
